Corten Apple & Pear Assembly Instructions:

Please note: The small apples and pears can be assembled by one person, but we recommend 2 people for both the medium and large sized fruit.

The points of the leaves are quite sharp – please take care during assembly.

COMPONENTS INCLUDED

- * 8 slices of fruit
- * 1 Bottom tube section with washer and nut
- * 1 Stem and Leaf top section with washer & nut

TOOLS REQUIRED

- * Sturdy Gloves
- * Adjustable crescent or 13mm spanner

Begin by removing the nut and washer off both the top and bottom tubes.

Starting upside down, take the bottom tube and begin slotting slices of the fruit vertically into the slots in the tube. It is easier to add these in opposite pairs to keep it balanced for handling initially, then when you have inserted 4 slices you can rest it on a hard surface to add the final segments.

Once all the slices are inserted, place the washer onto the bolt and screw on the nut **as loosely as possible**. This makes it easier to assemble the top.



Turn the apple or pear over until it is up the right way.

Hold the top section of the fruit by the stem and slot this down onto the slices of fruit, working around the sections one by one in a sequential manner. Lean the stem and leaf away from you as you work your way around. (Note that this part does take a little patience and perseverance).

Once you have all the sections in, with a little wiggle the top will slot fully down, and you can add the washer and nut onto the bolt. Tighten completely.

Lean the apple or pear over and tighten the bottom nut fully.



Congratulations! You now have a beautifully assembled piece of Heritage Garden Art which will age to a lovely rusted patina over time.
